- *The scores listed compare scores for each year (2006, 2007, 2008) for the same group of students at their grade level each year. For example, when looking at the 5th grade scores the first score is what those students achieved in 2006 as 1st graders, then in 2007 as 2nd graders, then in 2008 as 3rd graders, in 2009 as 4th graders and now in 2010 as 5th graders in the bold score. Scores from 2006-2008 reflect the *TerraNova*, Second Edition which cannot equally be compared to the 2009 and 2010 scores.
- **The 2009 and 2010 exam denotes scores from the *TerraNova*, Third Edition. Exams given in 2006, 2007 and 2008 were the *TerraNova*, Second Edition. The third edition features 2007 norms and offers in depth reporting in order to better measure student learning. The exam is more closely aligned to today's challenging content and national performance standards than the previous edition.
- ***The third edition did not feature a separate language score for levels 11 and 12 which are given in first and second grade. The language and reading scores were combined into one reading score at those two levels only.
- ****MNP (median national percentile) class averages are not computed for small groups, however, NP scores were provided for each individual student.
- The label "na" in a given year indicates that the students did not test in those specific years because they were in kindergarten or preschool and therefore testing was not available to them.
